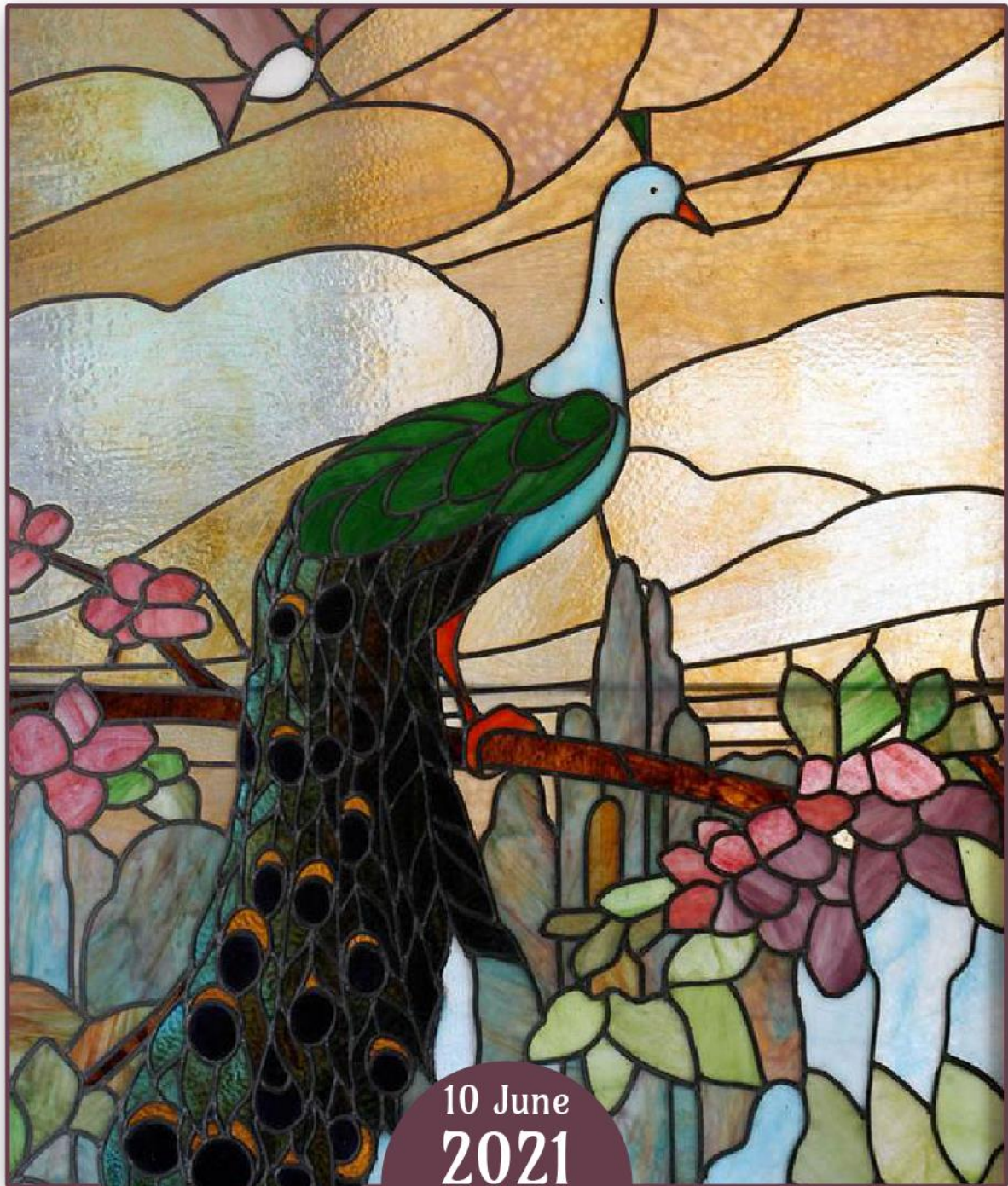

Hot Air Ballooning - Throughout the day

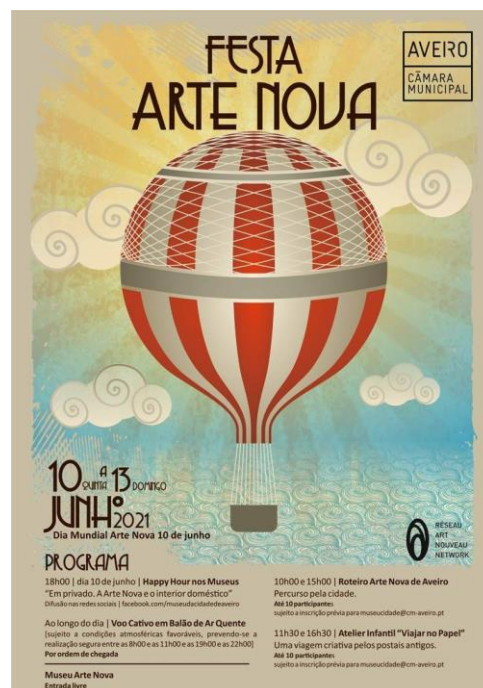
